Mr. Haynes: Please bring this suggestion to the attention of Steve Hill, Chairman Las Vegas Stadium Authority

At the corner of Sahara Ave and Paradise Rd is a large, paved parking lot with 1,000 - 2,000 + marked spaces. The SLS Hotel used it for employee parking. It is now vacant and for sale. I am retired and live nearby so familiar with it.

It is directly adjacent to the Paradise Road monorail station that can be used for travel to the stadium once the monorail is extended. People can reach it from I-15 via Sahara Ave and from the east on Sahara Ave. There is an excellent security fence around its perimeter. Vehicles enter/exit from both Paradise and Sahara.

It would provide a perfect *supplementary parking lot for stadium activities*. Due to its size it would be work well for Raider tailgate parties.

Plus the Convention Center could share in its cost to provide supplemental parking for their expansion with access via the monorail station or walking.
