## RESOLUTION TO AUGMENT THE STADIUM AUTHORITY WATERFALL RESIDUAL FUND (2965) OF CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022

**WHEREAS**, the revenues, transfers in, and beginning fund balance of the Stadium Authority Waterfall Residual Fund (2965) for Clark County, Nevada were budgeted to be \$9,950,141 on July 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the revenues, transfers in, and beginning fund balance in the Stadium Authority Waterfall Residual Fund (2965) are now determined to be \$11,680,780; and

WHEREAS, the source of funds for this augmentation will be provided by \$1,730,639 in additional revenue; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to apply these excess proceeds to be used for services and supplies.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Clark County, Nevada, Board of Directors of the Clark County Stadium Authority hereby augments its Fiscal Year 2022 budget by appropriating \$1,730,639 for transfers out in the Stadium Authority Waterfall Residual Fund (2965), thereby increasing its appropriations from \$9,950,141 to \$11,680,780. A detailed schedule is attached to this Resolution and by reference is made a part hereof.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Department of Finance forward the necessary documents to the Department of Taxation, State of Nevada.
