Mr. Haynes,

On 8/2/2021 I surveyed Allegiant Stadium to see the accessibility for ADA patrons (like myself), to access entry doors and the stadiums compliance and accommodations for ADA patrons in regards to Uber, Lyft and the proximity of the drop off & pick up of public transportation companies to the stadiums entry doors.

I spoke with the official parking company PATG and was told that Uber & Lyft drop off & pick up points were at least 1/8-1/2 mile from the exit doors.

Presently there are no golf cart type shuttle being used to accommodate ADA PATRONS.

Thus making Allegiant stadium somewhat NON ADA COMPLIANT. See Dodger stadium & Staples center in Los Angeles that provide shuttles at no charge for it's ADA PATRONS.

You will have a disaster if this isn't rectified before the Guns & Roses Concert at Allegiant Stadium on 8/27/2021. I spent over 2 hours talking with PATG staff & supervisors and on the phone with Raiders ADA PERSONNEL.

This eminent disaster can be avoided. The ADA shuttle contingency should have already been implemented.

Maybe there already is a plan.

You CANNOT HAVE DISABLED WALK IN THE LAS VEGAS HEAT.

I look forward to your reply before the meeting on 8/10/2021.
